## Make a day of it...

**HADLEIGH PARK** is a sensational venue with one of the UK's best mountain bike trails at its heart. It offers expanses of green space to explore, beautiful views over the Thames Estuary and is rich in history. Visit Hadleigh Park with its all weather, multi-user and all ability trails. **THE ROUNDHOUSE**, typical of the Iron Age, allows you to step back in time and glimpse our history. Opening times vary. **HUB CAFÉ** offers freshly brewed coffee and a selection of hot & cold food and a place to relax. Menu choices change daily with friendly staff and a warm welcome.

**HADLEIGH CASTLE** is an impressive ruin of a 13th century fortress, famously depicted in oils by John Constable. Free entry.

**RARE BREEDS CENTRE & CAFÉ** Discover a wide variety of friendly and wonderful rare breeds. Visitors can experience the working countryside, feed the animals or enjoy the willow maze. Charges apply.

## PUBLIC ARTWORKS

**THE REVEAL** (Heinrich & Palmer [www.heinrichpalmer.co.uk](http://www.heinrichpalmer.co.uk))

A Camera Obscura built into the hillside, *The Reveal* has been designed to be accessible for wheelchair users and provides the visitor with a contemplative space in which to rest and experience the world in a different way. It reflects whatever is outside so



will by its nature always be changing. Commissioned by Essex County Council and Place Services on behalf of The Greater Thames Marshes Nature Improvement Area Partnership and with support from Arts Council of England and the Olympic Legacy Interpretation fund.

**DISCOVERY TRAILS - THE WILLIAM BOOTH, JULIE BRESSET, DAMANT AND HUBERT DE BURGH TRAILS** are a series of four self-guided walks that enable the visitor to engage with a different aspect of the parks heritage or habitat.

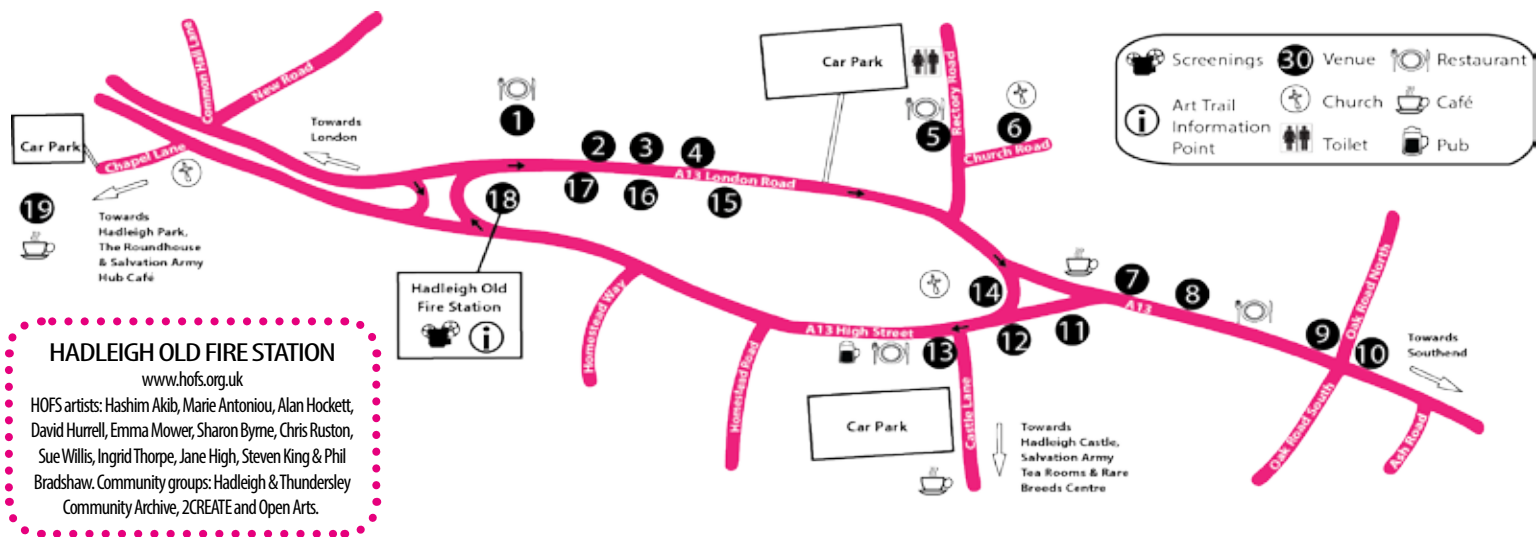

**ARCHAEOLOGICAL DIG**

Viewing only from High Street  
Hadleigh's very own 'Time Team', members of AGES AHA, will commence an archaeological investigation of the garden of the former Crown Pub (next to Hadleigh Old Fire Station). Previous local digs have found 12th & 14th century pottery and it is hoped this dig will unearth pottery from Saxon and early Norman periods from before the castle was built. Members of AGES AHA and Hadleigh & Thundersley Community Archive will be on hand to discuss finds & answer questions about the dig.
